WORK DAY—SATURDAY, MAY 21ST

Northwoods Archers club will have a work day on **Saturday, May 21st** beginning 8:00 a.m. Scheduled on the work agenda is the following tasks:

- Clear the walking trails and shooting lanes of fallen logs and brush.
- Fill in wet areas and haul wood chips on the trails as needed.
- Set up shooting stations by placing stands and stakes out on the course
- Rake the lawn, fill in holes with dirt, pick rocks, brush and garbage on archery course and rifle range. Level the mowing area on rifle range.
- Hang bow holders, donor signs and bridge rails.
- Reassemble moving targets and equipment.
- Inspect all stairs and hand railings.
- Refinish storage sheds
- Spring clean inside of the club house (clean windows, cabinets, walls woodwork and floors).

Equipment needed for tasks listed above: 4-wheelers, trailers, shovels, rakes, chainsaws and lots of hard working men!

Food and beverages are available for all workers. Workers are also eligible for incentive program drawings.



Northwoods Archers Club meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of every month. Meetings start at 7:00 p.m. and are held in the Northwoods Archers Clubhouse. All members or people wishing to join our club are encouraged to attend.

Outdoor 3-D Archery Summer League begins on Thursday, June 2, 2011. Archers can shoot on Thursday nights any time after 3:00 p.m. until dusk all summer. Our last night of league is September 8th. 20 targets will be set on either the North course, South course or Broken Arrow Lane.

The dumpsters were full and lots of roadway miles were covered thanks to all our dedicated volunteers braving the snow, wind and cold.

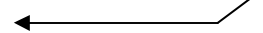
Pictured to the right are several volunteers at Perkinstown Dump during one of the many truck load drop offs.

NORTHWOODS ARCHERS OUTDOOR SUMMER LEAGUE

Just a reminder, summer league is fast approaching! The weather will get warmer and Thursday night archery league is less than one month away. Northwoods Archers 3-D League begins on **Thursday, June 2nd** through **September 9th**. Archers may shoot on Thursday nights after 3:00 p.m. until dusk. Twenty targets will be set hunter style on the North course, Broken Arrow blacktopped range or the South course. There are three stakes available for shooting with 20 targets placed throughout the woods with yardages ranging from

5 to 50. Archers will shoot at various targets from tower stands, on logs and in turkey blinds. Throughout the wooded course you will shoot at a climbing bear, turkeys roosted in a tree or a carp on the pond. There is a moving string target which simulates a walking fox. Other targets will have running game and animals roosted in the trees or on logs. You may notice a frog on the lily pad.

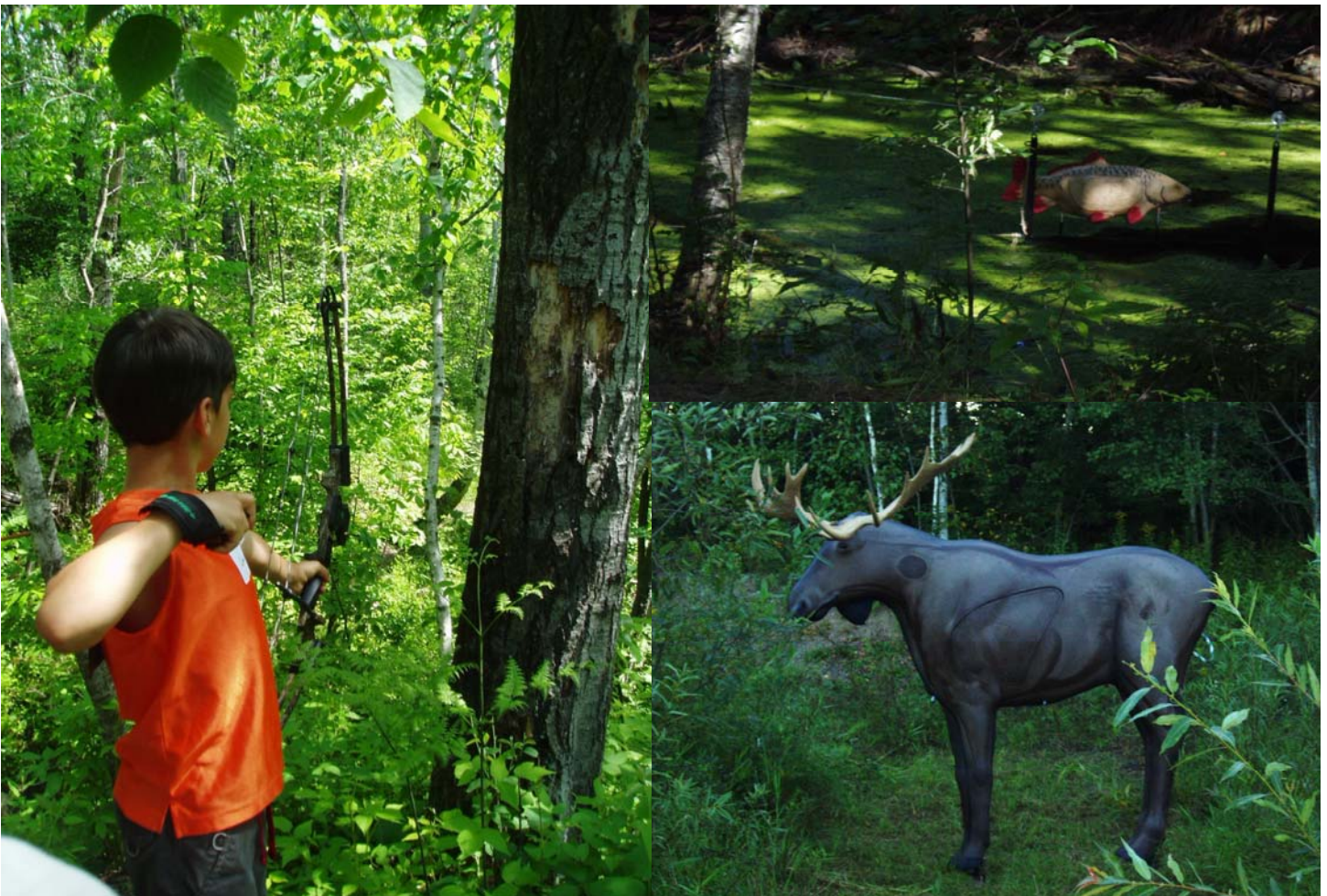
This is a fun league, it is not a scored event. You do not have to participate every week. Just come out and shoot for fun and brush up on your archery skills before

bow season. Kids 12 and under shoot for free.
