## YOUTH DAY—OPEN HOUSE

**SATURDAY, JUNE 12th**

This free event is available for all youth, women or anyone who wants to learn more about the exciting sport of archery and bow hunting.

### **BEGINNER'S COURSE**

Eight stations will be set throughout the woods. This course will take approximately two hours to complete. Stations include:

- Obtaining an archery license.
- Bow setup, arrow tuning, safety fundamentals and practice range shooting.
- 3-D target shooting.
- Compass use, deer tracking techniques, field dressing and tagging game.
- Tree stand safety and use.
- DNR regulations.
- Basic first aid.
- Question and answer session.

Bows and arrows are available for all archers, or you can bring your own equipment if you want.

### **OPEN HOUSE COURSE**

An advanced course will be set for those who have their own equipment and completed the archery course. You will shoot at 3-D Rinehart animal targets.

These targets can be shot at your own pace with assistance of an adult or a club member. Youth must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. This course will take approximate one hour to complete.

There is NO COST for participants on either course and a free lunch is included. There will random drawings for a variety of sporting goods.

A new youth bow will also be given away.

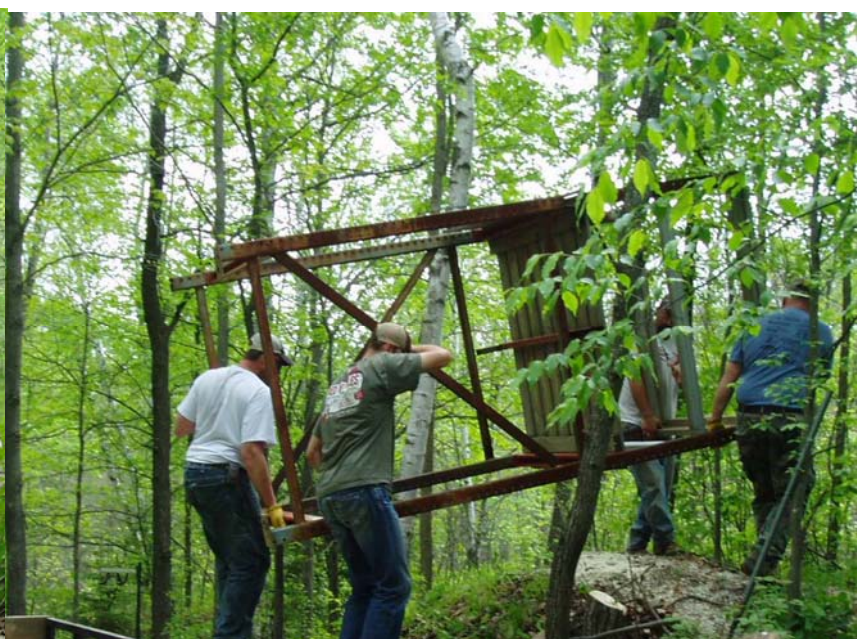
